

# CALL FOR PROPOSALS



## APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS FOR THE NAMIBIA FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION APPEAL COMMITTEE BY THE FIFA/NFA NORMALISATION COMMITTEE

In accordance with Article 8 of the FIFA Statutes, the Bureau of the Council decided on the 08 February 2019 to appoint a Normalisation Committee for the Namibia Football Association (the "NFA") with immediate effect. Further, that every person and organization involved in the game of football is obliged to observe the Statutes and regulations of FIFA.

In lieu of the abnormal state of affairs and the non-existence of an Appeal Committee to hear appeals, the NFA hereby calls for invitation to members of the public to form part of an Appeal Committee to be constituted in terms of Article 58 (5) of the NFA Constitution. The appointment and decision of the NFA Appeal Committee shall be ratified at the NFA Congress.

### Job Description

- Hearing appeals against decisions from the Disciplinary Committee and the Ethics Committee that are not declared final by relevant regulations of NFA.

### Requirements

- The applicant shall not have been found guilty of having breached the FIFA, CAF or NFA statutes or regulations in the past;
- The applicant shall disclose any activity, which may give rise to a conflict of interests, as such the aspiring applicant shall not form part of any FIFA, CAF or NFA structures either as a player or an official as defined by the NFA Statutes.
- A written undertaking to observe the statutes, regulations and decisions of FIFA, CAF and NFA;

### Prospective Candidates

- Two appointments with legal expertise;
- One appointment with an extensive sports administration background.

### Proposals should include the following information:

- Curriculum Vitae;
- Written declaration to observe the statutes, regulations and decisions of FIFA, CAF and NFA;
- Outline of any relevant experience on assignments of a similar nature during the last five years or any sport background, would be an added advantage;
